## RM of Spiritwood No. 496 Dust Suppressant Policy

Living in rural Saskatchewan, adjacent to a municipal grid road, may cause some challenges with dust, especially on a high traffic road.

The Rural Municipality of Spiritwood No. 496 (hereinafter referred to as the" RM") does not provide or compensate for dust suppressants. However, the RM does allow dust suppressants to the applied to roads under the RM's administration.

Property owners shall make application to the RM of Spiritwood No. 496 prior to the placement of any dust suppressant products being applied to the road. The application of canola oil is prohibited on municipal roads within the RM of Spiritwood.

A minimum of 5 business days is required, from the date the application is received, to the placement of the dust suppressant, for the application to be processed, approved and to allow adequate time for the road to be prepared to ensure the best result after the dust suppressant is applied.

It shall be the property owner's responsibility to apply or make arrangements to apply the dust suppressant.

The maintenance of municipal infrastructure shall take precedent and the RM reserves the right to gravel roads where dust suppressant may have been applied, or grade the road, if, in the municipalities' opinion, the road becomes a safety concern.

The municipality **will not** reimburse property owners for any costs related to the placement of the dust suppressant under these circumstances.
